

# **Golf Center of Arlington Junior Summer Golf Camp**

## **Participation Policies, Rules, and Liability Terms**

Participation in the Golf Center of Arlington Summer Camp program is subject to the following policies, rules, and terms. These policies are designed to provide a safe, respectful, and positive environment for all participants. Parents or legal guardians are responsible for reviewing these policies prior to registering a participant. Completion of the camp registration form constitutes acknowledgment that the participant and their parent or guardian have read, understood, and agreed to these policies as a condition of participation.

## **Assumption of Risk and Participation Terms**

Participation in golf instruction, practice sessions, recreational activities, and other camp-related programs involves inherent risks that cannot be completely eliminated regardless of supervision. These risks include, but are not limited to, being struck by golf balls or golf clubs, slips, trips, and falls on indoor or outdoor surfaces, injuries associated with athletic activity, weather-related conditions including high temperatures and sun exposure, and injuries that may occur through interaction with other participants or equipment.

By participating in the Summer Camp program, participants and their parents or guardians acknowledge these risks and voluntarily assume full responsibility for any injury, illness, loss, or damage that may occur in connection with participation in camp activities or presence at the Golf Center of Arlington facility.

## **IMPORTANT LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE**

**BY REGISTERING FOR OR PARTICIPATING IN THE GOLF CENTER OF ARLINGTON SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM, PARTICIPANTS AND THEIR PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIANS ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE THAT THEY ARE VOLUNTARILY PARTICIPATING IN ACTIVITIES THAT INVOLVE INHERENT RISKS OF INJURY.**

**TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY TEXAS LAW, PARTICIPANTS AND THEIR PARENTS OR GUARDIANS AGREE TO RELEASE, WAIVE, AND HOLD HARMLESS THE GOLF CENTER OF ARLINGTON, ITS OWNERS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, INSTRUCTORS, STAFF MEMBERS, VOLUNTEERS, AND AFFILIATES FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, LIABILITIES, DAMAGES, OR EXPENSES ARISING FROM OR RELATED TO PARTICIPATION IN CAMP ACTIVITIES OR PRESENCE AT THE FACILITY, INCLUDING CLAIMS ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE GOLF CENTER OF ARLINGTON OR ITS STAFF, TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.**

**BY REGISTERING FOR THE CAMP AND CONFIRMING AGREEMENT THROUGH THE REGISTRATION FORM, THE PARTICIPANT AND PARENT OR GUARDIAN ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THEY HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS LIABILITY WAIVER AND AGREE TO ITS TERMS.**

## **Participant Responsibilities**

All participants must follow instructions and safety guidelines provided by camp instructors and staff at all times. Golf equipment must be used responsibly and only as directed by staff. Participants are expected to behave respectfully toward instructors, staff members, and fellow campers, and to follow all facility rules.

Participants must wear appropriate clothing and footwear for golf and outdoor activity. Participants should bring water bottles, sunscreen, and other personal items necessary for outdoor participation. Any injury, unsafe condition, or concern should be reported immediately to a staff member.

Participants are responsible for their personal belongings. The Golf Center of Arlington is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal items brought onto the premises.

## **Camper Code of Conduct**

The Golf Center of Arlington Summer Camp is committed to providing a safe, supportive, and positive learning environment. Participants are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship, respect instructors and fellow campers, and cooperate with camp activities.

Disruptive, unsafe, or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. This includes misuse of golf equipment, refusal to follow staff instructions, bullying, harassment, intimidation, abusive language, or any conduct that interferes with the safety or enjoyment of others.

The Golf Center of Arlington reserves the right to remove any participant from the camp program at its sole discretion if behavior violates camp rules, creates a safety concern, or disrupts the camp environment. Participants dismissed for misconduct may be removed immediately and may not return. No refunds will be issued in such cases.

## **Drop-Off and Pick-Up Policy**

Parents and guardians are responsible for ensuring participants arrive on time and are picked up promptly at the end of camp. Camp supervision is provided only during official camp hours.

The Golf Center of Arlington is not responsible for supervising participants before or after scheduled hours. Parents must ensure campers follow check-in and pick-up procedures and notify staff if someone other than a listed guardian will pick up the participant.

Participants must remain within designated camp areas unless instructed otherwise. Repeated late pick-ups may result in additional fees or removal from the camp program.

## **Health and Safety Policy**

Parents and guardians must ensure participants arrive at camp in good health and are physically able to participate. Medical conditions, allergies, injuries, or physical limitations must be reported to camp staff in advance.

Participants who are ill, have a fever, or display contagious symptoms should not attend camp. Necessary medications must be clearly labeled and provided with instructions.

In the event of an injury or medical concern, staff may provide basic assistance and seek medical attention if necessary. Parents or guardians will be contacted as soon as possible.

## **Weather and Heat Safety Policy**

Camp activities may occur outdoors in Texas summer conditions, including high temperatures and sun exposure. Staff will take precautions such as rest breaks, hydration, and activity modification when needed.

Participants must arrive prepared with proper clothing, sunscreen, and water. Camp schedules and activities may be adjusted, relocated indoors, delayed, or cancelled at the discretion of staff due to weather. Weather-related adjustments do not constitute grounds for refunds.

## **Parent Responsibility and Damage to Property Policy**

Participants must treat all equipment, facilities, and property with care. Golf equipment, training aids, balls, mats, nets, and other materials must be used as instructed.

Parents or guardians may be financially responsible for damage caused by intentional misconduct, reckless behavior, negligence, or failure to follow instructions. Participants who intentionally damage property or repeatedly misuse equipment may be removed from camp without refund.

## **Program Changes and Instructor Substitution**

Camp schedules, instructional plans, and staffing are organized in advance but may be adjusted due to operational needs, instructor availability, weather, or other unforeseen circumstances. Activities may be modified, relocated, or rescheduled.

Instructors may be substituted if unavailable. These adjustments do not constitute grounds for refunds or complaints regarding services provided.

## **Cancellation and Refund Policy**

If a participant withdraws at least 14 days prior to camp, 50% of the registration fee will be refunded. Cancellations less than 14 days before camp are non-refundable.

No refunds are provided for missed days, late arrivals, early departures, or removal due to misconduct. The Golf Center of Arlington may cancel, reschedule, or modify sessions due to operational needs, safety concerns, or insufficient enrollment. In such cases, participants may receive a rescheduled session, program credit, or refund at the discretion of management.

## **Photo, Social Media, and Marketing Release**

Photos or videos may be taken during camp for promotional, educational, or marketing purposes, including the website and social media. By participating, participants and parents or guardians grant permission for these materials to be used without compensation.

Parents may submit written notice to opt out if they do not wish their child to appear in images or recordings.

## **Binding Arbitration and Venue**

Any dispute, claim, or controversy arising out of or related to participation in the Summer Camp program, including interpretation or enforcement of these policies, will be resolved exclusively through **binding arbitration** under the rules of the American Arbitration Association. Arbitration will take place in **Tarrant County, Texas**. Judgment on the arbitrator's award may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction.

By registering for camp, participants and parents or guardians **waive their right to a jury trial and to participate in a class-action lawsuit** regarding any claim arising from camp participation.
